Welcome CBMM Boaters!

It's a pleasure to offer our boaters overnight and daytime docking privileges, based on membership categories. Please familiarize yourself with CBMM marina rules and regulations, and the available docking areas. Membership is required to use our marina facilities. Memberships can be purchased or renewed at CBMM's Welcome Center upon arrival, in advance online at cbmm.org/membership, by calling 410-745-4991 or emailing join@cbmm.org. Please note that overnight docking is only available to Mariner level members and above and Day Docking is available to Household level members and above. Contact the Dockmaster at 410-745-4946, VHF Channel 16 or by email at dockmaster@cbmm.org with any questions.

CBMM Marina Policies:

- for your safety, no swimming, fires or fireworks in the marina
- **we cannot guarantee specific slips**; slips will be assigned at time of arrival to best accommodate as many vessels as possible
- all boaters are expected to follow basic courtesy standards to fellow boaters, CBMM guests and staff
- all guests arriving by water not covered by a CBMM membership are required to pay admission
- pets are expected to remain on a leash at all times. Animal waste disposal bags are located on campus. Pets are not permitted inside of exhibition buildings. **Please note that during CBMM festivals & special events, pets are NOT permitted on docks or CBMM grounds**
- **Pump-Out Station:** A pump-out station is available to all boaters at no cost on F Dock behind the Small Boat Shed. It is available daily during operating hours. Please visit the Welcome Center for assistance or call 410-745-4946
- running an engine while docked is prohibited, and only minor repairs allowed in dock spaces
- disorderly conduct or excessive noise will be cause for revocation of docking privileges
- alcoholic beverages should not be consumed on CBMM grounds or docks and should remain on your vessel
- boats may be moved if left unattended without a reservation
- please refrain from displaying political signs, placards, banners, or flags while docked at CBMM

Advance Reservations:

- accepted in the order received, except for special events and on holiday weekends when reservations require a two-night minimum stay and can only be made up to one month prior to the event or holiday
- **payment is required when reservation is made** marina space will be guaranteed with a paid reservation, however **we cannot guarantee specific slips**

Hourly Docking with availability

- docking is available from 9am–5pm Sunday to Thursday and 9am–2pm Friday & Saturday
- available free to members on a **space-available basis**
- **authorization by Dockmaster via radio on VHF channel 16 or by phone 410-745-4946 is required prior to arrival**
- all boaters **MUST** check in at the CBMM Welcome Center on arrival; no advance reservations are accepted
- **PLEASE NOTE that hourly docking space is limited** and often unavailable on busy summer weekends, and **is NOT available on holidays and CBMM festivals**

Overnight Docking:

- check-in time is noon; check-out time is 11:30am
- available to **Mariner** level members and above at the following rates:

\$2 per foot	Sun-Thurs (min. \$50)
\$2.75 per foot	Fri-Sat & holidays (min. \$75)
single 30 amp	\$15/night
twin 30 or single 50 amp	\$20/night
100 amp or twin 50	\$50/night
pump-out station	no charge
- includes free Wi-Fi, climate-controlled showers, CBMM bicycles, picnic tables
- ice is available for sale in the Museum Store
- **please see reverse for holiday and festival policies**

Dinghy Dock:

- available to members provided they check in at CBMM's Welcome Center upon arrival

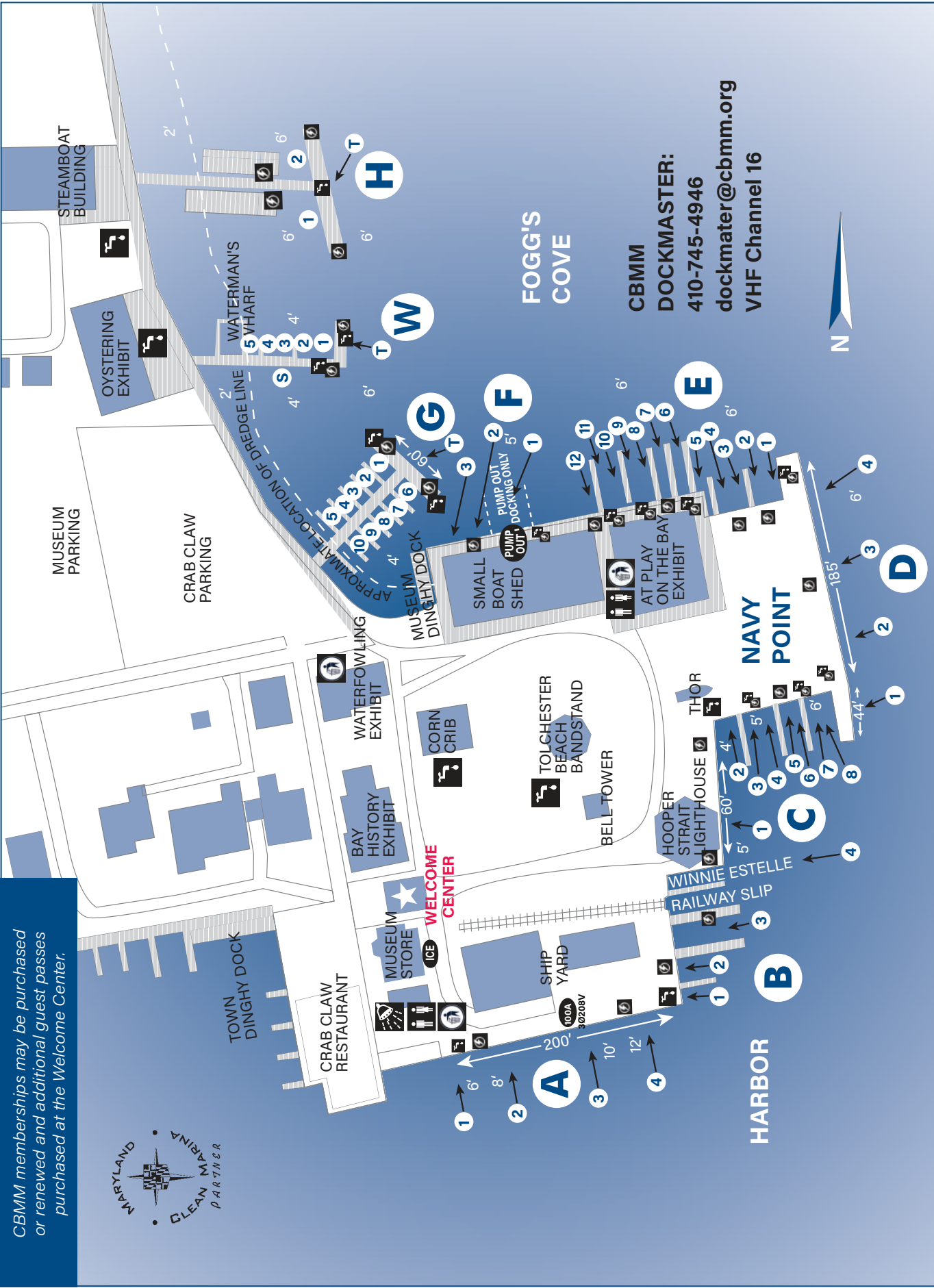
Holidays and Festivals:

- two-night minimum required
- 72-hour cancellation notice required for full refund
