Welcome CBMM Boaters!

It's a pleasure to offer our members, at the Mariner level and above, overnight and hourly docking privileges. Please familiarize yourself with CBMM's marina rules and regulations, and the available docking areas. Memberships can be purchased or renewed at CBMM's Welcome Center or South Entrance upon arrival, in advance online at cbmm.org/memberships, by calling 410-745-4991 or emailing join@cbmm.org. CBMM's Members-Only Marina is partnered with Dockwa. Members are encouraged to download the Dockwa app or go to CBMM's page on the platform to seamlessly request reservations, receive confirmation, and communicate with marina staff. Contact the Dockmaster at 410-745-4946, VHF Channel 16 or by email at dockmaster@cbmm.org with any questions.

CBMM Marina Policies:

- For your safety, no swimming, fires or fireworks in the marina.
- We cannot guarantee specific slips; slips will be assigned at time of arrival to best accommodate as many vessels as possible.
- All boaters are expected to follow basic courtesy standards to fellow boaters, CBMM guests and staff.
- All guests arriving by water not covered by a CBMM membership are required to pay admission.
- Pets are expected to remain on a leash at all times. Animal waste disposal bags are located on campus. Pets are not permitted inside of exhibition buildings. Please note: During CBMM festivals & special events, pets are NOT permitted on docks or CBMM grounds.
- Pump-Out Station:** A pump-out station is available to all boaters at no cost on F Dock behind the Small Boat Shed. It is available daily during operating hours. Please visit CBMM's South Entrance for assistance or call 410-745-4946.
- Running an engine while docked is prohibited, and only minor repairs are allowed in dock spaces.
- Disorderly conduct or excessive noise will be cause for revocation of docking privileges.
- Alcoholic beverages should not be consumed on CBMM grounds or docks and should remain on your vessel.
- Boats may be moved if left unattended without a reservation.
- Please refrain from displaying political signs, placards, banners, or flags while docked at CBMM.

Advance Reservations:

- CBMM members are encouraged, but not required, to use the Dockwa platform for booking reservations.
- Reservations are also accepted via phone (410-745-4946) and email (dockmaster@cbmm.org).
- Advance reservations are accepted in the order received, except for special events and on holiday weekends when reservations require a two-night minimum stay and can only be made up to one month prior to the event or holiday.
- Payment information is required when reservation is made. Marina space will be guaranteed with a paid reservation, however we cannot guarantee specific slips.

Hourly Docking (with availability)

- Hourly docking is available from 9am-5pm Sunday to Thursday and 9am-2pm Friday & Saturday.
- Hourly Docking is available at no additional charge to Mariner level members and above. Authorization by Dockmaster via radio on VHF channel 16 or by phone 410-745-4946 is required prior to arrival.
- All boaters MUST check in at CBMM's South Entrance on arrival. No advance reservations are accepted.
- PLEASE NOTE that hourly docking space is offered when space is available and NOT available on holidays and CBMM festivals.

Overnight Docking:

- Check-in time is 1pm; check-out time is 11am.
- Overnight Docking is available to Mariner level members and above at the following rates:

- Overnight stay includes free Wi-Fi, climate-controlled showers, CBMM bicycles, and picnic tables.
- Ice is available for sale at CBMM's South Entrance.

Holidays and Festivals:

- Reservations are accepted one month prior.
- Full payment is required at time of reservation.
- Two-night minimum is required.
- 72-hour cancellation notice is required for full refund.
- Docking at CBMM is very limited or unavailable on certain holidays, festival weekends, and special events.
