IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Restrooms** Portable restrooms are located throughout campus. Permanent restrooms are located inside the Welcome Center, At Play on the Bay, and Steamboat Building, and next to the Marina Guest Center.
- Food** Steamed crabs will be available for purchase at the Talbot Watermen Association tent, beginning at 11 am. Crabs will be sold at \$40/dozen and include two ears of steamed corn. Various food, drinks, and snacks will also be available for purchase throughout the day.
- Pets** Please leave pets at home! During festivals and special events, dogs ARE NOT permitted on CBMM grounds for safety reasons, except for certified service dogs.
- Alcohol** Beer may be purchased on site ONLY—no carry-on alcoholic beverages, from boat or land. Please have your ID ready to purchase beer.
- First Aid** Go to the first aid station near the Mill Street drive-thru gate next to the boardwalk.
- Emergency** Dial 911, and report the incident to the Welcome Center.
